- Develop curriculum that aligns with NCSY goals.

- Train NCSY staff and advisors in delivering both formal and informal education effectively.
- Provide tools to help staff:
  - Facilitate meaningful conversations
  - Build educational continuity
  - Inspire and mentor teens
- Serve as a thought-partner to program directors and educators.

- Define and track the **student journey** from first touchpoint to long-term engagement.
